**Dear University for Peace Community,
Students, Faculty and Staff,**

The UPEACE Coronavirus Task Force would like to update you on the following:

The University **remains open** and is taking steps to safeguard the health of its community.

Among these safeguards, we would like to remind you of the following:

- The UPEACE recreational park is **closed** until further notice.
- The University is teaching all its classes **online**.
- The University has been applying the **teleworking** modality for non-essential personnel since last week.
- The library is open Monday through Thursday from 8am-2pm. People interested in visiting it are requested to make an appointment, in order to comply with the rules of social distancing indicated and to reserve the space on the bus, in case they require institutional transportation.

To reinforce the aforementioned measures, the following decisions were made today:

- To **close the main campus of the University for Peace on Fridays, beginning on Friday 27 March 2020** and until further notice, as a further preventive measure.
- Teleworking continues as it has for non-essential personnel, with essential personnel joining the teleworking modality **on Fridays only**.
